

Will of Jane B. Hester

Georgia Berrien County

I Jane B. Hester of said State and County being of sound mind and disposing memory do make this my last will and testament

First - I give bequeath and devise to my niece Horace Blunt - and my old servants Nilot - and Nan Hester the following property. One Hundred and twenty two and one half (122½) Acres of land in the north east corner of lot no. Four Hundred and ninety seven in the Sixth district of said County to have and hold said property together so long as they all three live and at the death of the old servants Nilot - and Nan Hester the property to vest absolutely in said Dorie Blunt
