

State of Georgia, County of Berrien.

Last will and Testament of James B. Moore.

I, James B. Moore, of said state and county, being of sound mind and memory, do make this my last will and testament.

Item First: I wish my executor or executors, as soon as possible after my death, to pay my debts, if any are owing by me. If the sale of property shall be necessary, I wish him or them to make same from my personal property, if any be owned by me, and if not, select for sale that which can be most advantageously used for that purpose; and I authorize him or them to sell the same, if personal property, after advertisement, at my late residence, and if land, at public or private sale, as he or they may see fit.

Item Two: I give to my beloved wife, Mollie Moore, the sum of Ten Dollars (\$10) in cash, to be derived in the manner as funds are derived for the payment of debts, if any be left by me.

Item Three: I bequeath, at my death, to my sons, Lacy J. Moore and Aulie Moore, all the real estate of which I am seized and possessed at the date of my death; but said Lacy J. Moore and Aulie Moore shall, as soon as practicable after my death, get three disinterested free-holders to appraise said lands, and said Lacy J. Moore and Aulie Moore shall, as soon as said lands have been appraised, determine the share going to each of the following named children, which are all of my children to wit: Minnie Herring, Lacy J. Moore, Mamie Allen, Orie Moore, Jennie DeLoach, Aulie Moore, Annie Moore, Thelma Moore, and

by said appraisement to be divided share and share alike between my said named children, and shall then pay to said children, share and share alike, his or her proportionate share derived from said fixed valuation, but, should said Lacy J. Moore and Aulie Moore be not able to buy said other seven interests, or whatever number of interests may remain in the event of the death of anyone of said children before my death, in said lands, or should either of them be dead and the other not able to do so and choose not to do so, then, and in that event, said lands shall be sold by them or either of them after advertisement in the official newspaper of Berrien County where the sheriff's advertisements are run, for four weeks, before the court house door in said County, and the proceeds divided between said named children, share and share alike.

4 Item Four: I give and bequeath, at my death, to my children, Minnie Herring, Lacy J. Moore, Mamie Allen, Arie Moore, Jennie DeLoack, Aulie Moore, Annie Moore, Thelma Moore and Nannie Kate Moore, as above set forth in Item Three of this will, and in addition thereto they shall have share and share alike the proceeds that may be derived from the sale of all personal property, cash, notes and accounts that may be owned by me at the date of my death.

5 Item Five: Should any of said named children be minors at my death, then I hereby designate and appoint Lacy J. Moore and Aulie Moore guardians for said minor or minors, and authorize them to take, retain and handle the said proceeds which shall belong to said minors or minors under the terms of this will.

ship to continue during the full term of the minority of said minor or minors, and at the expiration of said guardianship they to make an accounting to said minor or minors for such handling of his or her estate.

6 Item Six: I do hereby appoint Lacy J. Moore and Aulie Moore my executors of this my will, and here and now relieve them of the trouble and expense of giving bond and making returns to the Court or Ordinary, or to any other court, and should either of them be deceased before my death, then the other is hereby made the sole executor of my will, and all rights given under the terms of this will to be held and enjoyed by him.
