this my last will and testament
Item first I give bequeath and devise to my
wife Mary C Williams the following property
To wit: Two hundred & fifty acres more or less
of Lot of Land #. 191. lying and being in
the 9th Dist of said County and known as
my entire interest on said Lot of Land
One Bay mare of small size about eighteen
years old. One or white & yellow pided
Thirteen head of stock cattle marked
two underbits in each ear.

Seven head of stock Hogs marked two
underbits in each ear.

Five head of Goats unmarked

One horse cart and all other plantation
tools.

One Sugar mill and boiler.

Fifty bushels of corn more or less

Five hundred lbs fodder more or less

One Barrel of Syrup & half Barrel of Sugar
and five head of meat Hogs. Together with
all other provisions kind belonging to me
free from all charge or limitation to her
own proper use benefit & behoof.

Item Second

I hereby constitute and appoint my
friend Thomas A. Baker Executor of
this my last will & testament
