as follows continued on the North by
lands of Mrs J. E. Alexander and Marian
Alexander on the East by lands of
Jesse McMillian & Rendul McMillian
on the South of lands of O. H. McCook on the
West by lands of Asa Myrie giving and
granting to J. E. Benefield for and
during his natural life as afore said
with the remainder over at his death to
his heirs in equal parts share and
share alike.

Item 4)
We hereby constitute and appoint of
O. H. Cook the sole executor of this
our last will and testament and we
expressly confer upon his power as such
to administer our estate excusing him
from giving any bond or making any
return to the Ordinary and be
excepted from all such

authority and power to sell any part of our
estate not hereinbefore specially devised

same uses and trusts as hereinbefore declared
