and gratification for many and long continued
services running Agency through many years
done and performed by Sarah Samantha
Clements for me and on my behalf.
I do hereby give and devise & bequeath
to said Sarah Samantha Clements for and
during ~~the~~ natural course of her life
all that certain lot piece or parcel of
land situated lying and being in the
West of Berrien County said State
of Georgia described as follows beginning
at a stake on the South East Corner of
lot of land known as Number four
hundred and seventy six (476) in said
County, and running thence north along
line of said lot to Big Creek thence
up the line of Big Creek to the mouth of
popular branch thence strating up said
Branch to the mouth of a ditch thence
westwardly along said ditch to the line of
the Kartville Road thence South along
line of said Road to the original
East and West line of said lot thence
eastwardly to the original line of said lot

less, with all the rights, Minors and
Tenancies to the same in any manner

25th 1885. And the other note for One Hundred
and fifty Dollars due Dec 25th 1886. And
the father will desire and bequeath to the
said Serranther Clemens All of my per-
sonalty of every Nature and Kind Whatsoever
Including the Crop Growing on the place
where I am living this year All Horses and
Mules, Cattle, Sheep, Swine, hogs Plantations
Lands Buggy Sledge Buggy Wagon and furniture
All my household and kitchen furniture
&c &c (Selling and excepting only certain pro-
mising Notes hereinafter mentioned) Her and
her Natural life And After his Death, I
desire and bequeath the same to my be-
loved and Adopted Son Albert C. Cornell
forever And whereas I have paid quarter
debt and conveyed the plantation, where
I am now living consisting of One Hundred
and forty eight Acres more or less to Luther
Liles and Benjamin L. Liles the sum then due
is paid. Therefore now I do father desire
and will that at the time of my death
any of the said Notes should be due and
unpaid together with all the Notes not due,
shall be equally divided among my
Children

Except the two notes of \$125⁰⁰ and
\$150⁰⁰ as above set forth and I think
that my money arising from the pay out
of said notes in my person in at the time
of my death shall also be equally divided
among my three children as expressed
except the two notes set forth

of this my last will and testament hereby
revoking all former wills by me made
