Will of J. E. Cornell

Georgia Berrien County

I John E. Cornell of said State and County being of sound and disposing mind and memory do make this my last will and testament

Item 1st - I give bequeath and devise to my grand sons Leonard G. & Jay N. Cornell the following property to wit - Two Thirds interest in lot - No. 181 in the 9th Dist. of said County it being all of lot - lying North of Briskey Creek and West of Siquem Branch containing 80 acres more or less

Item 2nd I give bequeath and devise to my grand sons Leonard G. & Jay N. Cornell the following property to wit - (8) Eight - Head of black cattle Two Thirds of the stock of sheep marked Prop split in one ear and upper square in the other ear The said property is valued at \$400 - Four Hundred Dollars

Item 3rd if one of my grand sons Leonard G. or Jay N. Cornell should die before they are age then all the property mentioned in this will shall belong to the living grand son mentioned in this will

Item 4th I hereby constitute and appoint my friend J. H. Martin & my son D. S. Cornell Executors of this my last will and testament
