I John W Hall of Tipton Berrien
County Georgia make this my last Will.
that is to say (after necessary expenses of a
decent burial has been deducted, I give devise
and bequeath my estate and property real and
personal as follows That is to say I devise
to Warren D. Hall the plantation upon which
he now lives and being the plantation owned
by my mother Sarah Hall, during her life
time. I also bequeath to him Warren D Hall
the sum of Two Hundred Dollars \$200⁰⁰
in money. and my horse and Buggy should
I own a horse and Buggy at the time of
my death. I bequeath to Luciza Basford
the sum of One Hundred Dollars \$100⁰⁰ in
money. I bequeath to Josephine Hall the
sum of Two Hundred Dollars \$200⁰⁰ in
money I bequeath to Laura J Lovell the
sum of Twenty five Dollars \$25⁰⁰ in money
I bequeath to Mitchell G Hall my Gold
Watch and Chain the remainder of my
property real and personal. I give devise
and bequeath Equally to Mitchell G. Hall
Camilia Jane Hall and Rebecca O. Cunnell
And I desire and direct that the same be
equally divided among Mitchell G Hall
Camilia Jane Hall and Rebecca O. Cunnell
I appoint Mitchell G Hall My Deputy
Marshal of Berrien Co. Executor of
this my will. I desire and direct that
my executor be not required to give Bond.
