Last will and testament of John Murray
I John Murray of said state and county
being of sound and disposing mind and
memory, do make this my last will and
testament.

Item 1) I wish my executor, as soon as
possible after my death to pay my debts
If a sale of property shall be necessary, I
wish him to select for sale that which
can be most advantageously used for that
purpose; and I authorize him to sell the
same at private or public sale, as he
may see fit.

Item 2) I give to my beloved wife Sallie
Murray for and during her natural life,
the following property to wit: 210 acres
more or less of lot of land # 79, in the 10th
District of Berrien County Georgia and
described as follows. Bounded on the North
South & West by the original land lines
of said lot, and East by an agreed line
and lands of Jasper Grimes. Also 70
acres more or less of lot of land # 132,
in the 10th District of Berrien County
Georgia described as follows. Bounded
North by the original land line of said
~~lot~~ ^{land} East, South and West by agreed lines
and land of Jas. Grimes. Also all my house
furnish & kitchen furniture consisting of
beds, bedding, bedsteads, chairs, tables,
cooking utensils etc. also all money notes
and accounts, horses, mules, cattle, hogs,
plow tools and gear, buggies, wagons etc.
in fact all my personal property of
whatever character, nature or description
that I may have, with remainder over
after her death, to my two
daughters Marahie Murray and
Annne, Sallie Murray.

Item 3) Should my said wife die

event, I give and bequeath all the aforesaid described property to my two said daughters who have lived with me for the best several years, and took care of my said wife and myself, and who entitled to said property for such service rendered, and to be rendered.

(Item 4) I do hereby appoint J.W.E. Pavell executor of this my last will without bond. In testimony whereof I have hereunto set my hand this 11th day of January, 1923.
