 memory. Knowing that I must shortly
 depart this life, deem it right and proper
 both as respects my family and myself
 that I should make a disposition of the property
 with which a kind providence has blessed
 me I do therefore make this my last will
 and testament hereby revoking and annulling
 all others by me heretofore made

First: I desire and direct that my body be
 buried in a decent and christian like
 manner suitable to my circumstances and
 condition in life. my soul I trust shall
 return to rest with God who gave it, as
 I hope for salvation through the merits
 and atonement of the blessed Lord and
 savior Jesus Christ

secondly, I desire and direct that my
 just debts be paid with out delay
 by my executrix and executor herein
 after named and appointed.

Thirdly, I give and bequeath and devise to my
 beloved wife Mary Ann B. Clyatt, the
 whole of my property both real and
 personal for and during her natural
 life or widowhood to be managed
 and controlled by her as she shall deem
 best and at her death or intermarriage
 with any other man to be equally
 divided to share and share alike among
 my legal heirs. Those of my
 children who may have received any
 advancements to duly account for
 the same so as to make the shares
 of each equal.

Fourthly. I hereby constitute and appoint
my beloved wife Mary Ann C. Clyatt
executrix of this my last will and
testament. And my son William H.
Clyatt. Executor on his arriving
at the age of twenty one year.

Fifthly. Should my wife Mary Ann C. Clyatt
intermarry with any other man
it is my will and desire that
her executrixship shall then cease
and my son William H. C. C. C.
be my sole executor. and I will
and direct that in that event
he shall proceed at once to distribute
my estate among my lawful heirs
giving to my wife a child's part there.
This provision for my wife is
made in lieu of any claim
for dower she might have out-
of or on my estate.
