

Will of Mary Jane Smith
State of Georgia, Berrien County.

I Mary Jane Smith of said State and County being of sound and disposing mind and memory, do make this my last will and testament hereby revoking and annulling all others by me heretofore made,

1. I will and devise that my estate shall be administered on by John Dixon Smith,

2. I will and direct that all my just debts be paid

3. Having divided our home place between Fion and Jew mill crucks into shares for all the heirs and having given a deed in fee simple to Rachel A. Susan E. Cassie J. Osborn L. and Brazil N. and not having given deeds to Sarah L. Mary Ann. John D. Martha B. and Kessiah A. for their shares; and having sold their shares and reinvested the profits on same in The City of Nashville, I will and devise the following disposition of all my property.

I will and bequeath to Rachel A.; Cassie J.; Susan E. The sum of one dollar each (\$1)

I will and bequeath to Brazil N. A portion of my estate equal to one hundred (\$100) dollars (because he has not received the benefits of the Turpentine and Saw mill privileges, nor the share of the bunch of Cattle).

I will and bequeath all the remainder of my estate any where and every where, to Sarah L. Mary Ann. John D. Martha B. and Kessiah A. to be divided equally among them.
