State of Georgia & In the Name of God Amen
Berrien County & I Mary A. P. Powell being in
Very low health but of sound
and disposing mind do Make this my last
Will and Testament hereby revoking all
others heretofore made by me.

Item 1st I desire and direct that my body be
buried in a decent and Christian like
Manner suitable to my Condition in life
My Soul I trust will return to God
Who gave it, as I hope for eternal
life through the blood of Jesus Christ
Item 2nd I desire and direct that my Just
Debts be paid at once as there will be
No necessity for delay by my executor
here after named.

Item 3rd I desire and direct that my
Estate which consists of about Eleven
Hundred Dollars in Notes be taken charge
of by my Executor hereinafter named and
that the same after paying all my Just
debts and ^{such} other legacies as I shall
Charge upon my Estate be loaned out at
Interest only such amounts to be used
as my Executor shall deem Wise and
expedient to pay out to the support
of my Children and in their Education
untill my Son John shall become of
age at which time I direct that
the Equal portion of my said Estate that
shall remain in my Executors hands be
paid him and likewise as the remainder
of my Children shall become of age
to wit Thomas H. Mathis, Henry, James Henry
and Molly Vid Powell.

Item 4th I desire and direct that my
Executor shall pay to Mrs. Mary Blitch

One Dollar per week for so long a time as she shall stay with my said Children. Or if they shall remain on the homestead, untill all of ^{them} shall have attained the age of fentie years at which time the Law gives them right to chouse Guardians

Item 5th. I desire and direct that W. H. Sneed be appointed Guardian for my said Children provided the necessity of such course shall be deemed necessary.

Item 6th I desire and direct that W. H. Sneed My friend act as My Executor of this my last will and testament and that the necessity of making annual returns to the ordinary be obviated.

At this my request that no return be made Only Every Five years and then only when changes of waite be made to said Court

Item 7th I desire and direct that my Children heretofore named shall remain together at the homestead untill some of them shall come of age and if convenient untill the youngest Child shall become of age.
