I desire and direct that all my just
debts be paid without delay by my executors
hereafter appointed as I am unwilling
my Creditors should be delayed in their rights es-
pecially as there is no necessity for such delay
3rd Item

I give, bequeath and devise to my be-
loved Son Matthew Albritton Everett and to my
beloved daughter Rachel Louisa Everett
to each of them \$500 and nothing more
4th Item

I give and bequeath to my other two
children to-wit James Thorne and Susan Everett
the Balance of my property and effects
to each of them share and share alike consisting
of the West half of Lot of land numbered 571
Four Hundred and eleven and Stock horses
Cattle Hogs and Kitchen furniture

which land is at present Deeded to O. K. Jones Esq
as security for money borrowed which if I should
die before the said borrowed money is paid
and said land is redeemed I desire and
direct my Executor to pay said money and redeem
said land and then that the same together with any
thing else which I may possess be equally
divided between my two children named above
James Spoin and Susan.
Sixth Item.

The reason I make the above dis-
tinction between my children is because I
have been an afflicted sufferer for the last
twelve years, and the said James Spoin and
Susan, have devoted themselves to me and
have supported me and taken care of me
and as I possess but a ^{very} small Estate, I deem
it but Justice that they should have the little
I may have.

I hereby constitute and appoint
my son James Spoin Esq Executor of this
my Last Will and Testament This October 23rd
