whom Christian Duties I have strictly
observed for the last eight months

2 Item I, Desire and Direct that all my
Just debts be paid as soon as my
Executors here after appointed
can Realise the money out of my
property to pay the Same

3 Item I give bequeath and Devise to
my Beloved Wife Elizabeth with
whom I have lived in the Street
quiet for one year all my stock
of Cattle Consisting of Seven head
of neat Cattle I also give
her all my household

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and kitchen furniture, all without Reserve or limitation

4th Item I Request that all my
Specie, horses and all of property
be Sold, that I here pass
by Executors

5th Item, I Request that my Executors after
they Sell off all my property & collect
the money for the same to pay to my
friend Mark Lott my trustee one
Thousand Dollars to be applied for the
Education and Support of ^{three} Children
here after named here after named
to wit Christy Davis and Margaret
Davis ~~and~~ Thomas Davis the heirs of
Hulda Davis

6th Item, I further more Request that
after the one Thousand Dollars
be paid the Remainder of the
amount of the proceeds of my property
Belongs to my Beloved Wife Elizabeth
for and During her natural Life
to Dispose of at her pleasure

7th Item, I hereby constitute and appoint my
worth friends Oscar Edenfield & Byron
D. Mobley Executors of this my last
will and Testament this ~~November~~
