

Will of W. H. Bost

Georgia Berrien County

In the Name of God Amen,
 I William H. Bost of said County & State
 being of advanced age and knowing
 that I must shortly depart this life deem
 it right and proper as respects my
 legal representatives & myself that I should
 make a disposition of the property which
 a kind providence has blessed me
 to therefore make this my last will
 and testament hereby revoking all others
 heretofore made by me

1st Item

I desire & direct that my be buried
 in a decent and Christian like manner
 suitable to my conditions and circumstances
 in life my soul I trust shall return
 to rest with God who gave it -
 as I hope for an eternal salvation through
 the merits and atonement of the blessed
 Lord and Savior Jesus Christ

2nd Item

I desire and direct that all my
 just debts be paid without delay if
 any by my executor hereinafter appointed
 as I am unwilling my creditors should
 be delayed their rights

3rd Item

I give devise & bequeath unto
 my dear and lawful wife Jennie
 Bost all my real and personal
 property of every kind during the course
 and term of her natural life save
 & except that I give my son Jesse when
 he shall have arrived at the age of
 18 years or 21 years and when at
 20 years of age

To my daughter Mary at the age of 20 — 5 head of cattle one cow and pigs
To my daughter Gemma at age of 20 years
4 head cattle 1 cow & pigs and my Arrilla
at the age of 20 years 4 head cattle one
cow & pigs and before the final division
of said estate my 4 youngest children
she paid 210⁰⁰ To wit: Mary 60⁰⁰ Lily Alice
Gemma Fifty dollars Jane Fifty dollars
and Arrilla Fifty dollars and at the final
division of said estate there + Mary, Gemma
Jane and Arrilla have and equal portion
of balance estate
4th Item
