also Three Twelfths of my personal
property

Item Third; I give and bequeath
to my beloved daughter Mamie Savelge
Cannon one Twelfth of my personal
property Less Four Hundred Dollars
for which I hold note

Item Fourth. To my beloved daughter
Julia McKay Harrell. One Twelfth
of my personal property

Item Fifth; To my beloved daughter
Jane Augusta Cannon. One Twelfth
of my personal property

Item Sixth; To my beloved daughter
Aimie Laura Harrell one Twelfth
of my personal property

Item Seventh;
To my beloved daughter
Ethel Savelge Harrell. To one
Twelfth of my personal property

Item Eighth. To my beloved daughter
Willie Virginia One Twelfth of my
personal property

Item Ninth:

To my beloved son Henry
Orice Harrell One Twelfth of my
personal property

Item Tenth:

To my beloved daughter
Emma Ruth Harrell One Twelfth of
my personal property

Item Eleventh:

To my beloved daughter
Betha Harrell One Twelfth of
my personal property
