

DeKalb County, Georgia.

I, Wycliffe Gaskins, of said State and County, being of sound mind and memory, do make, publish and declare my last Will and Testament as follows:

Item 1.

I desire and direct that my body be buried in keeping with my position in life in the Fletcher Cemetery near Alapaha, Georgia, and that a suitable marker be placed to my grave in accordance with the direction of my beloved wife and my beloved father and my executor hereinafter named.

Item 2.

I direct that my debts be paid as soon after my death as is practicable.

Item 3.

I will and direct that as soon as Item I and II. of this my Will shall have been put into effect, and sufficient funds withheld by my executor hereinafter named to meet the expenses of the Administration of my estate, that all the balance and residue of my estate shall be divided into two equal shares; one of which shares I give and bequeath to my beloved child Christie Gaskins to belong to said Child in fee simply but with the condition that should said Child die without leaving issue then any remainder of said share of my estate thus bequeathed to said Child not already used or consumed by her shall immediately vest in my beloved father, Eston H. Gaskins, or in his estate should he be deceased at the time and to go to his lawful heirs; the other one-half of my estate not so bequeathed to my child Christie Gaskins as above provided in this Item of my Will.

I give and bequeath to my beloved wife Charlotte Gaskins for and during her natural life with Absolute rights and power to dispose of any or all of it by deed for her personal benefit, as fully as I might do were I in life, but with this limitation, that in the event of her death without her having made disposition for her own benefit of all said share of my estate, then I will and direct that such remainder shall immediately vest in my said child Christie Gaskins, if she be in life at the time or if she be dead then to her living issue, if any but in the event of the death of my said child without ~~living~~ issue, then such remainder shall instantly vest in my beloved father, Eston W. Gaskins, or should he pre-decease my said child or her issue then said remainder to vest in the lawful heirs of my said father Eston W. Gaskins. This bequest to my beloved wife shall be and is in lieu of dower and all right of dower, and in lieu of years support and all right of years support, of my said wife in and to my estate.

Item 4.

I appoint and name my beloved Uncle W. M. Gaskins, in whom I repose full confidence and trust, Executor of this my last Will and Testament.

Item 5

I further name and appoint as Trustee and Testamentary Guardian of the person and property of my child Christie Gaskins, my beloved father Eston W. Gaskins, he to not only have in trust and manage for its benefit its said property as bequeathed under the terms of my Will but in the event of the death of my beloved wife, its mother, before said

Child becomes twenty-one years of age or marries, then he to have its Personal Custody Until said Child reaches the age of twenty-one or marries, and I hereby empowers and direct my said Trustee for my said Child that he manage the said property herein bequeathed to said child to the best of his skill and ability and to use not only income from said estate for the benefit, support, maintenance and education of said child, but likewise when necessary in his discretion to use so much of the Corpus of said estate as he shall deem best for the benefit of my said child. The said Trustee and Testamentary Guardian to turn over to my said child, Christie Gaskins when she reaches her majority all of said property and estate so handled by him as Trustee not consumed for its benefit or expended in lawful expenses in the handling of its said property. But, in the event of the death of my said child before she reaches her majority leaving any issue, then said Trustee to account to said issue or legal Guardian. In the event said child, Christie Gaskins, die leaving no issue, then said Trustee to account to the beneficiary as provided in this Will.
