I, Ann Wiley of said County, being a g.d., and  
infirm, in body, but of sound mind, and memory,  
do, make, publish and declare this to be my last  
will and testament

First = I give and bequeath to Leroy M Wiley  
and John B Wiley the following Negroes  
to wit: Saucha a man Sixty years of age - Sarah  
a woman about Sixty five years old, and Sarah  
a woman about fifty eight years old, to have and  
to hold the said Negroes, to the said Leroy M Wiley  
and the said John B Wiley, during their joint lives  
and upon the death of either of them, them to the  
Survivor. With my Express wish that they the said  
Negroes should always be taken care of and  
well treated

Second = It is my Will and desire that the  
Negro woman Maria shall have the privilege

of Choosing ~~any~~ my child and, or others, some person to buy her, and it is my wish, that my Executor, in accordance, with such choice shall sell at private sale, and for a reasonable price said Mary Woman, Maria and her Child or Children, with the Exception of the two which I have already sold, with the intention of Keeping her and her husband together if possible

Third = All my furniture, which is now in Macon I give and bequeath to my son John W Wiley

Fourth = The balance of my Estate I wish after my death to be Equally divided between my three Daughters, Mary Baxter, Eliza J. Carny, and Sarah Ann Hays and to my two Grand Daughters, Susan L McCay and Anna. Eliza Winsley I have and I have alike

Fifth = I wish all my debts, if I have any paid, and I appoint my sons, Leroy W Wiley and John W Wiley and John L. Hershaw my Executors to this my last will and testament and do hereby revoke any other will which I have heretofore made.
