All the rest of my Estate, both real and personal I give and bequeath unto my said Son Thomas and my Daughter Ellenor Shaw aged Shaw also Equally to be divided between them, their heirs Executors and Administrators, and in Case Either my said Son or Daughter shall die leaving no issue, and the other in life then the Survivor, to take the whole. It is my wish, and so I direct that my said Son Thomas shall support and take care of his Mother Ellenor Doyle in a becoming manner during his life

I do hereby appoint my Son Thomas my Sole Executor of this my last Will and testament
