

George Bibb County In the name of God Amoz & Edmund Gilbert of the County aforesaid Statute affore said being of sound and disposing mind and memory do make ordain & declare and publish this to be my last will and testament in manner and form following to wit

Son. First. My will is that all my just debts be paid

Son. 2^d My will is that my son ~~John Buleas & Gilbert~~ receive from me one Bed or one of them to be furnished as those were that my other children received. My will further is that my three sons Edmund & John Buleas & Gilbert each receive one Bed; that will make my children equal in this article of Beds.

Son. 3^d My will is that all the Negroes I may own at my death be divided into seven lots and drawn for at the prices that they may fairly appraise or estimate by the following children to wit. Rebecca Staley's children Edmund & John Buleas & Josephus Gilbert & G. Catharine Sned and Josephus' children in trust for Sarah Frances Sims; which is to be accounted to them in part their distributive share of my estate.

Form of the My will is that the balance of my Estate both real and personal be sold by
My executors at such time and place as they may think best for all concerned
and be equally divided between all of my Children Share and Share alike
after each one accounting for what he or they have received from me as follows:
Sophiah W. Bidwell has received \$2,200 twentytwo hundred dollars Bibb Co. It shall be
received in his life time \$725 Seven hundred and twentyfive dollars Edmund G.
has received \$700 Seven hundred dollars, John B. has received \$750 Seven hundred
and fifty dollars, Malcomb J received in his lifetime \$700 Seven hundred
dollars plus to him now in addition \$1100 One thousand one hundred dollars. A G. Garrison
will be received \$1000 one thousand dollars, Sarah Frances Ulms has received
\$1000 one thousand dollars, and Deborah Gilbert has received \$800 eight
hundred dollars) or may receive hereafter from me or from my Estate
taking the same in part of their distributive Share of my estate, and in those
cases where my children have died and left child or children said child
or children shall receive that portion that would be coming to its parent
in life so as to make all of my children in the final settlement of my
Estate share equally. Malcomb J. Gilbert's children are to receive

Item 5th My will is this that the portions of My Estate that would be going to My daughter Sophia W. Beddoe be given and equally divided between her three daughters Mary Walker Martha Simpson and Commissor Williams

Item 6th I now will and bequeath to my beloved son Josephus Gilbert all that part of My Estate that would be going to My Daughter Sarah Francis Mims for trust for her her and her children receiving all the benefits of the same by the said Trustee administering to her wants whenever necessary to the full amount of the income of the same either by Rents fine or Interest by the said Trustee to be the sole judge and Manager of the same so long as the said Sarah Francis Mims shall live and at her death to give the said Share to her children in fee simple.

Item 7th I likewise appoint my sons Julius & Josephus Gilbert to be Executors of this my last will and testament and they are hereby made and constituted the same.
