Being about to return to the Army & being of sound mind & health, I think it a duty I owe to my family to make such disposition of my worldly effects as will be for their temporal good & comfort I Edward Ebenezer Brewer do make & declare this to be my last Will & Testament,

1st

I hereby appoint my beloved Wife Caroline Elizabeth Brewer my executrix & direct that after this my last Will has passed Probate & been admitted to Records & my estate both Real & Personal has been appraised and the appraisement returned to the Court of Ordinary, that she shall not be required to make any further Returns to either the Court

of Ordinary or any other Court whatever while she remains my Widow I give all my estate both real & personal together with all bonds & other evidences of debts in trust to my Executrix Caroline Elizabeth Brewer that after my just debts are paid, the rents & income of my real estate & interest on all bonds & notes to be devoted to her own support & the support & Education of my children during her Widowhood,

Item 3^d

Should my Widow marry again, in that event I direct that my Estate be divided into four equal parts & that one fourth of all my Estate be placed in the hands of a suitable trustee for her own individual support & support during her natural life & at her death to be equally divided between my children then in life should any of them die leaving no children then my Estate as above stated to be divided so as to give to each living child an equal share with my Widow should either my children depart this life & leave an heir or heirs such heirs to receive their mother's share.

Item 4th

I hereby authorize my Executrix to sell any or all of my real estate either privately or at public auction as she may think best with the advice of her friends & to the same give titles as fully as I could do were I in life & invest the proceeds of such sales in other real estate to be in trust as stated in Item 2^d.

Item 5th

Should my Executrix die being my Widow & not having married again I direct that all my property be placed in the hands of competent trustees & as my children become of the age of twenty years or marry they to draw their share of my Estate to be held in trust for them & if my children should any one or more of them die leaving no children or children that portion of my Estate such child has received to return to & become a part of my Estate for the benefit of the survivors. In testimony whereof I Edward Ebenezer Brewer do hereby make & publish this to be my last Will & Testament revoking all other Wills & testaments made by me & to be signed by me & my hand & affixed my seal this the seventeenth day of February eighteen hundred and four
