I Elizabeth S. Champion of Bibb County Georgia, being weak in body but of sound mind and memory, do make publish and declare this my last will & Testament, hereby revoking all other will and testaments by me made

Item

1st I will and direct that all my just debts be paid
2nd I give & bequeath to my son Aaron S. Champion in trust & confidence never to be used for the sole and separate use of my daughter Emily S. Kirkpatrick wife of William N. Kirkpatrick of Atlanta Georgia the whole of my estate real & personal of every kind or nature what so ever wherever the same may be situated upon the uses and trusts following

1st To pay and apply the interest & income of the whole of my estate real & personal to the comfortable support and maintenance of my said daughter during the full period of her natural life and at & from and immediately after her death to divide & distribute the whole of said estate real & personal as follows to wit
One full half of said estate to the children of my said daughter Emily S. Kirkpatrick living at her death and the other full one half to the children of my son Aaron S. Champion then living that is living at the death of said Emily S.

3rd By way of advice & direction I have state that I am entitled as of my own right & property to the following assets
notes 1 note on P. B. Pudley date 19 Dec 1854 for \$208.62
1 note on J. L. Holland date 16 Dec 1855 for \$201.54
1 note on J. L. Holland date 9 Oct 1852 for \$216.25 with a credit of \$720.00 & interest paid to 13 Oct 1855
A. H. Champion note date 20th July 1853 for \$200.00
C. D. Battick note date 1st Jan 1854 for \$212.00
E. H. Gray note date 6 Oct 1854 for \$625
in hand of C. D. Battick for collection
Durham & Swansons note in hand of J. L. Holland for collection for \$150.00 Two notes of cheas about two hundred dollars each in or left in my name by J. L. Holland and placed by me in his hands for collection

4th As direction to my executor I have state that I have an interest in a steam saw mill & lands under the contract of Henry C. H. H. he agreeing to advise with me in the profit of the mill for an amounting sum
