I therefore make this my last Will and Testament
as follows to wit: viz:
First, I Will and devise to my beloved
Wife Anna Johnson all that Tract or Parcel
of Land Situate lying and being in the fourth
District of formerly Houston now Bibb County
adjoining Lands of Woolfolk Wm. Rainery Wm.
Ashy Chas. Stroger and Wm. Higgins containing
one hundred and fifty Acres more or less
Also two Mules one Haggan two or three
head of Sheep one Cow and one or two
of Hogs Also all my Household and Kitchen
Furniture consisting of Six Beds furniture
clothing one Table one Chair and one
Chest of Drawers The above named Goods
being both or unaltered to have and to hold to
and for the use and benefit of my said Wife Anna
Johnson during her natural life for her

242 I, *Henry Johnson* do hereby constitute and appoint *James H. P. Laney* and *Charles Stroger* my Executors and I will and devise that at the decease of my said wife that all the above named and described property be sold in terms of the Law and the Proceeds Equally divided between my Children which I may leave at my death. I will and devise that at my death there be paid at my death to my said wife $\frac{1}{4}$ of the said property and I will and devise constitute and appoint my said wife *Anna Johnson* my executrix to carry this my last Will into effect and that the provisions of said Will do not go into effect till after my death.
