Do make & constitute this my last Will &
Testament. Requeathing my soul to God who gave it.
I desire that my body be decently interred in accordance
with my Condition & circumstances while in life;
I give & bequeath all my estate both real & personal to my
Wife Mary Bailey for & during her life, she to have the
Management of said property during her life & is to receive &
use the income above, none of said Estate shall be incum-
bered either by Mortgage or debt or in any other manner nor
shall it be sold during her said life, nor shall any of
said Estate except the income thereof be liable for her debts
Contracts or debts.

After the death of my Wife the said Mary Bailey I give
& bequeath the whole of said Estate to the Children of
my Sister Mary Bailey (who is now dead) in two equal
to be divided equally between them share & share alike
In Witness Whereof I the said James Bailey to this my
last Will have hereunto set my hand & seal this the fifth
