 effects personal property to have and to hold the same for the support
 of herself and my two children Joseph Farrell and Thomas H.
 Farrell after paying all just and lawful debts out of said estate
 and after her death the said property to be divided between my
 two children if living and if they both die the remaining to
 be divided to my next of kin now living in New York I hereby
 nominate and appoint my worthy and esteemed friend John
 Malone my guardian over my wife and children to carry
 into effect my last will and testament
