Item 1st I desire & direct that my body be immediately removed to Union Hill Washington County there to be buried by the side of my Parents My should trust will return to rest with the God who gave it as I hope for eternal salvation through the merits & atonement of our Lord & Saviour Jesus Christ whose religion I profess & enjoy

Item 2^d I desire & direct that my just debts be paid without delay

Item 3^d I give & bequeath to the Theological Seminary located at Columbia South Carolina the sum of one thousand dollars to be invested to aid in the education in that Institute of poor young men for the Gospel Ministry

Item 4th I give and bequeath to the trustees of Oglethorpe College located at Midway near Milledgeville Georgia the sum of five hundred dollars to be by them invested as a permanent scholarship in that institution

Item 5th I give to my beloved grand niece Mrs. James T. Rush of Texas the sum of five hundred dollars

Item 6th I give & bequeath the sum of five hundred dollars to my friend Mrs. Louisa Earnest of Macon Georgia with whom I now reside

Item 7th I give to L. B. Lamer Esq. of Macon Ga. the sum of five hundred dollars for & in consideration of his professional services

Item 8th I give to Rev. J. L. Loma of Columbia or Carolina to Miss Margaret Hays daughter of Rev. J. Hays of Athens Ga. or to Miss Susan of Macon Ga. the sum of five hundred dollars

The last Will & Testament of Miss Jane Irwin continues

Item 9th I give to Miss Anna Early the sum of two hundred dollars in trust for Mrs Anna Early during her life and at her death to her daughter both now living in Jefferson Co Ga

Item 10

I give to my nieces Isabella Irwin Whitaker & Elizabeth Whitaker both of Atlanta Ga the sum of fourteen hundred dollars each

Item 11th I desire & direct that my three Slaves should I make no disposition of them during my life shall be sold unless my Heirs shall prefer to take them or either of them at fair valuation in lieu of their legacies

Item 12 I give to Jackson Barnes of Macon Ga one hundred dollars in trust for Mr John Early during his life & for his children at his death provided that there be that amount of the foregoing Legacies

Item 13th I give to Revd Dr Selana of Columbia So Carolina & Revd Dr Stalmage of Midway Ga seven hundred dollars in trust to be invested by them to aid in the support of one Presbyterian Missionary for the State of Georgia The preceding Legacies to have precedence of this in payment

Item 14th I give to Lucius the eldest son of L B Lamar of Macon Ga my gold watch

Item 15th I give to the three youngest Sons of Simon Whitaker deceased the sum of four hundred dollars to be equally divided between them. The preceding Legacies to have precedence of this in payment

Item 16th

The residue of my estate should there be any I give to Revd Dr Selana Stalmage & Hove in trust for the interest of the Theological Seminary at Columbia So Ga the Oglethorpe College & for the support of the Gospel in Georgia — I hereby constitute & appoint Mr Jackson Barnes of Macon Ga The Rev Dr Stalmage of Midway Ga. the Rev Dr Selana of Columbia So Carolina & Lucius B Lamar Esq of Macon Ga executors to this my last will and testament

 as may be convenient to be by her used & appropriated as she
 may think fit, for the use and benefit of herself & my
 sister Louisa M. Weed Caroline A. Weed & my brother
 Joseph E. Weed without accountability to any body whatever
 during the time that my said sister shall remain single
 and my said brother shall be a minor
 When my brother Joseph E. Weed shall attain to
 the age of twenty one years then it is my will that
 the one third part of the estate so invested
