The Last Will and Testament of John Samar

- Item 1 I John Samar of the County and State
of Georgia do intend this will to be a
final disposition of all my property and
I hereby revoke all other wills made by me
- Item 2 It is my will that so soon after my death
as possible, my Executor pay my debts, my
funeral expenses, and appropriate such sum
as he may deem proper for a suitable ma-
nument or tombstone to be erected over my
grave - and to pay Eight Dollars in cash
a monument for my deceased Brother
Henry H. Samar -
- Item 3 It is my will that my Executor sell
my real and personal Estate, at public
or private sale, as he may deem best, and
the proceeds of said sale with the money
I have on hand, and all debts due me to
be collected, and laid in trust by him for the
interest or annual proceeds, or so much
thing as may be required to be appropria-
ted for the purpose of giving my three
youngest Sisters, Michel H. Samar, Matilda
Julia Samar, and Ada Lockman Samar a
musical Education and the principal
with whatever interest may accumulate

the advances for the purpose aforesaid
to be held in trust by said Executor until
the youngest Ida Lockraw shall. Many to
arrive at the age of twenty one years, at
which time the same to be divided in three
equal parts. One Third to go to my youngest
brother Clementine & Samas to be held in
his own right, to him and his heirs forever.
One Third of my said Estate to be held by
him in trust to land for the sole and separate
of my Sister Matilda Julia to be no way
liable to any contract which any husband
she may have. Should she hereafter marry
for and during her life, at at her death to
go to her child or children, but should
she die without a child or children or
without a grand child or children, then
the same is to go to my brother and sister
surviving her, and the other third part to be
held in trust as aforesaid to the sole and
separate use of my sister, Ida Lockraw Samas
for life, and at her death, without child or
children, or grand children ~~or~~ children then
the same to go to my brother and sister
surviving her

Hereby. I do hereby constitute and appoint
my Father Henry & Samas, my Executors
to this my last will and testament, whereof
I have set my hand this the 6th day
of June A.D. 1854. John Samas
