County being of advanced age & knowing that I must soon
depart this life deem it right and proper both as regards my
family & myself that I should make a disposition of the property
with which a kind Providence has blest me do therefore make
this my last Will & Testament hereby revoking all others heretofore
made by me

Item 1st

I desire & direct that my body be buried in a decent Christian
like manner suitable to my circumstances and condition in
Life my soul I trust will return to rest with God who gave
as I hope for eternal salvation through the merits & atonement
of the blessed Lord & saviour Jesus Christ

Item 2nd

I desire & direct that all my just debts be paid without delay
by my executor herein after appointed as I am unwilling that my
Creditors should be delayed in their rights especially as there
is no necessity for delay

Item 3rd

I give and bequeath to my beloved wife Mary with whom
I have lived forty four years for and during her natural
Life only one Lot of land number (7) seven in Vineville
containing one half acre with all the rights members
appertaining to said lot of land in any wise belonging free
from all charges or limitations whatever to her own
proper use & benefit & behalf I also give & bequeath to my
beloved wife in like manner the farming utensils of
every description whatever & one mule two horses one cow
and calf and one two horse wagon & a one horse wagon
also I give to my beloved wife Mary in like manner
for and during her natural life six negro slaves
(to wit) Abanria a woman about twenty years old & her
three children Rody a girl about six years old & Bling
girl about four years old & Sally a girl about two years
old & Morrae a yellow boy about fifteen years old &
Henry a boy about twelve years old & all my house hold
& kitchen furniture & after the rent of the farm in the
swamp is paid which my adopted Son is tending with
ballance of the proceeds of said farm to be brought here
for the support of the Family, I also give and bequeath my
beloved wife Mary a Land warrant for one hundred and
twenty acres of land which I expect to get or is coming
to me, this I wish her to dispose of for the use of herself
& family as she may think best

Item 4th

I also desire is that after the death of my wife that
Morrae the yellow boy named above shall be the
property of William Thomas Taylor Paterson Son of my
adopted son, also I desire that the yellow girl named
Sally to belong to Sarah Ann Taylor Paterson daughter
adopted daughter of said Paterson & that

a woman by the name of ~~Elizabeth~~ her two children
Rodney & Mary & their increase & Henry shall be equally divided
belovist Francis Paterson Mary Elizabeth Martha Jane Alexander
Stephens Paterson Children of my adopted son J. S. Paterson & his
present wife & should they have any more children while
living together as man & wife my desire is that they also
may come in for an equal share with the last named
three children and should either of the negroes willed away
to William Thomas Taylor or Sarah Ann Tappley Paterson die before
they are of age then I wish for either or both to come in
for a equal share with their other brothers & sisters

Item 5th I give and bequath to Jefferson S Paterson my adopted son
Lot of Land No 499 four hundred & ninety nine in the
(1st Dist) Eleventh & (1st) first section in Cherokee containing
fourty acres with all the rights members of pertannance
to said Lot of Land belonging free from all charges or
limitations whatever to his own proper use & benefit &
behoof forever with full power to dispose of the same at
any time he may think proper

Item 6th I hereby appoint my beloved wife Mary my executrix &
Jefferson S Paterson my executor of this my last will & testament
and also wish the whole of the property kept together until
the youngest child is fourteen years old & in case J. S.
Paterson dies & leaves his present wife a widow for her to be
supported out of the property as long as she lives a widow

Bibb County } I know all men by these presents that aforesaid being of & disposing mind and memory but being weak in body and knowing the uncertainty of the duration of this present life do make and publish this my last will and testament

I nominate and appoint my friend ^{Anderson} Andrew Corner the executor and my beloved wife Harriet B. Freeman the executrix of this my last will and testament

Commending my soul in the hands of a merciful God I desire that my body be buried in a manner suitable to my circumstances and at the discretion of my executors

I will that all my just debts be paid and for this purpose I empower my executors with power in their discretion to sell such portion of my estate real or personal as may be deemed by them necessary for this purpose either at public or private sale as may be best for the interest of my estate

I will and desire that all my estate except such portion as may be sold for the payment of my debts be kept together and managed by my executors for the support and maintenance of my family and for the support and ^{education} of my children for and during the life or widowhood of my beloved wife, if my wife should again marry then on the happening of that event they will so that my estate real and personal be equally divided between my wife and children share & share alike and this for

my wife is made in lieu of dower in my real estate should my wife continue in widowhood during her life then at her death my will is that my estate be equally divided among my children share & share alike and on the division of my estate on either the above events happening should any of my children then be living ^{children} children then being such child or children shall stand in the place & stead ^{share} of the deceased parent and to have

share that would if living be coming to him or her in the event the distribution of my estate by either of the above mentioned should be made to the children or any of my children
