In the name of God Amen.

I John Scott of the County of Bibb & State aforesaid, being of sound body & possessing a natural mind, do make & ordain this my last Will and Testament.

I give my body up to earth whence it came.

I wish a decent burying.

I give to Quincy Shunkley, five hundred Dollars to be paid out of my Estate at my wife Christian Scott's death.

I give to my wife Christian Scott all the rest of my Estate, both real & personal after paying all my just debts to dispose of as she thinks proper. I do hereby appoint my wife Christian Scott Executrix, and John Davis and William Johnson Executors of this my last Will and Testament Given under my hand & seal this 13th day of November 1824
