and all the Effects and property I may die possessed
of during her natural life or habitation and
at her intermarriage or death I wish my

Item 4th I do hereby appoint Elizabeth A. Sharp my
wife as executrix to this my last will
and also William A. Sharp, and Robert A. Sharp
my children above mentioned Executors to this
my last will and Testament as aforesaid
dated this Twenty-fourth day of November in
the year of Lord, One thousand Eight hundred
and thirty four.
