State and County aforesaid, being of sound
disposing mind and memory, and desiring to
settle all my worldly affairs, while in health
and strength do make public and declare
this to be my last will and testament

I give and bequeath to my beloved wife
Elizabeth Bond my dwelling house and lot
all the lot or parcels of lot owned by me in the
City of Macon in said County, also my horse
carriage, household and kitchen furniture and
stock of every kind by me owned and possessed
in said City of Macon. Also the following named
servant, Calum a man, Alongo a man, Eliza
a woman and her children, Angeronia a woman
and her children, Lemmy a woman, Ellen a woman
and Mary a woman. To have and enjoy to
her use and benefit during her natural life and
at her death to be equally divided, share and
share alike amongst my children then surviving
and the representatives of any one or more of my
children who may be then deceased, such representa-
tives or Representatives of a deceased child taking
in share.

2 I give and bequeath to my beloved wife
Elizabeth Bond my Colarabau Plantation in the Second
District of originally Baker but now Dougherty, and
in said State containing three thousand acres of
land more or less together with all the stock pro-
visions, fixtures and appurtenances thereon belonging
and the following named Negroes to wit: Moses
and his wife Patsy and their children Abner and
his wife Polly, Savony and his wife Phyllis and
their children, Charles and his wife Lorry and
their children, Sarkin and his wife Nancy and
their children, Adam and his wife Betty
Howard and his wife Patsy and their children
Evans and his wife Mary and their children
Elijah and his wife Martha and their children
Sally and his wife Maria Porter and his wife
and their children Paul and his wife Sally
and his wife Sally, Washington and his wife
Maw, Catharine a girl a young woman

and Hudson Arrow " To have and hold to his
Sole use and benefit during his natural life, and
after his death to be divided amongst my Children
who are living and the representatives of such as are
dead. Equally share and share alike, in all
respects, as is provided in the first above items
of this Will

Item 3rd It is my will and desire and instruction that
my Executors and Executors hereinafter named,
within twelve months after my death or as soon
thereafter as it can be done to a advantage, sell
all the residue of my Estate both real and personal,
not specifically named and bequeathed in
Items One and Two (1 & 2) of this Will on a
Credit of one and Two years for notes with three
good and responsible names to each note, bearing
interest from date and when they mature collect
the same and invest the money in safe reliable
dividend paying Bonds and Stocks, issued within
the State of Georgia for the benefit of my Children
Maria L Bond, Mary Jane Bond, Lemmy Bond,
Harry Clay Bond and any Child or Children
that may be born hereafter. Such of said Children
to be entitled to Education and maintenance
and support out of the proceeds of said money
so invested in Bonds and Stocks, and each of
daughters on marrying or arriving at age
to draw her share of said investment, and each
of my sons to do the same on arriving at maturity
one year of age, and in case of the death of
one or more of my Children, to be equally divided
between the survivors

Item 4th I name constitute and appoint my party
friends Thomas H Moughan William S Moughan
and my beloved wife Annetta S Bond the Executors
and Administrators of this my last Will and
Testament and Guardians of my Children

Item 5th It is my will and desire that my Executors
and Administrators above appointed, should keep
the my whole Estate until all the debts
may show at my death are fully paid off
and discharged, and then proceed at once to
settle up and divide and invest my Estate
