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 Last Will of Julia Kelly, Decd
 On the name of God Amen.

Julia Kelly of the City of Macon and County of Bibb in the State of Georgia do make this my last will and Testament

First, I direct that all my estate both real and personal be sold and the proceeds applied as follows

Secondly, I will that my funeral expenses and all my lawful ^{debts} be first paid out of such proceeds.

Third, I will and bequeath all that remains to my only child Patrick Henry Kelly for his support and education in the doctrines of the Roman Catholic Church and in a sound English education, the residue will to be placed at his disposal after he will have arrived at the age of twenty one years

Fourth, Should my child die during his minority I bequeath all the foresaid property then remaining to be equally divided among Margaret Thomas and Owen Children of my sister Mary Kellen lately deceased, the foresaid children now living in Ireland should one or two of the foresaid children of my sister die during minority the portion or portions then remaining to be given to the surviving

Fifth, Whereby appoint Thomas C. Dempsey and George S. Rogers both of the City of Macon Bibb Co Georgia Executors of this my last will and Testament

Sixth, I appoint my brother Patrick McKevitt of Macon Co Perm the Guardian of my son Patrick Henry Kelly

Seventh, I hereby revoke and declare null and void all my former Wills Testaments and Codicils and I declare this my last will and Testament Whereunto I set my hand and seal this First Day of December A.D. 1856
