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Last Will and Testament of Nancy Kennedy Decd

Georgia
Bibb County } In the Name of God Amen,
I Nancy Kennedy of the County of Bibb and State of Georgia being of sound mind and disposing mind and being desirous to settle my worldly affairs, while I have strength to do - do make and publish this my last will and Testament revoking all Wills by me at any time heretofore made;
And first I commend my soul to God who gave it and my body I desire to be buried in the Grave Yard at Philor Church in Bibb County and my worldly estate I dispose of as follows:
Item First I desire my just debts paid also my body to be buried at the burying Grounds above mentioned.

Item Second I desire all my Estate to be equally divided between my dear children as early as convenient, there being no cause for delay, to wit Elizabeth & Burkett to take one share during her life and at her death to heirs of her body, not to be spent by her present or any future husband should she have one;
Item Third; My Daughter Mary Bradley to take one share during her life & at her death to dispose of as she may desire not to be subject to her husband's debts present or future should she have one;

Item 4 I desire my Daughter Mary Ann Stallings to take one share during her life & at her death to the heirs of her body not to be spent by her present or future husband should she have one.

Item 5 I give;

My Grand Son William Pelix Kuekaby to take one share when he shall arrive at the age of Twenty one years should he die without children to return to my living children if there be any surviving to the heirs of their body; I make and appoint Arthur D. Harman the Receiver of his my Grand Son William Pelix Kuekaby Share to keep at Interest till he shall arrive at or to the age of Twenty one, should he die without children his Share to return as above stated to my heirs or the heirs of my third body.

In Witness whereof I the said Nancy Kennedy to this my Will consisting of the foregoing Set my hand and Seal this 30th day of January 1863;

Item 6th I appoint Robert Burkett my Executor,
