Saylor Executors of Mrs. Martha Matthews & produced her foregoing last will & testament & also the two Codicils thereto to wit, one dated May the 20th 1856 & the other dated June 18th 1856 & which last codicil is hereto attached the office being hereon written and also one of the witnesses to said will & two codicils, to wit Wm. Leonidas Holt which said witness being duly sworn depose & says that he saw said Mrs. Martha Matthews the testatrix sign seal declare & publish the instrument now presented as her last will ~~and~~ also the said two Codicils thereto freely voluntarily & of her own accord & without any compulsion or influence whatever: That at the time of executing said will & said two Codicils said Testatrix was of sound and disposing mind & memory, that this deponent signed said will & Codicils as a witness in the presence of the Testatrix & at her special instance & request & saw the other witnesses to said will & Codicils do so likewise & that all the witnesses signed the same in the presence of each other Sworn to & subscribed before me

The Last Will and Testament of Olive Dillard

Georgia }
Bibb County }

On the name of God Amen —

O Olive Dillard being in feeble health and knowing that all must die — being of sound mind and memory, do make publish and declare this my last will and testament hereby revoking all wills by me heretofore made

I wish all my just debts paid as soon as possible after my death

I give my son Manning Dillard my land scrip or Bounty Warrent for Eighty (80) acres of land — If the warrant is located in my lifetime & give him the land to him & his heirs forever — This in full of all claims on my estate

All the rest and residue of my estate both real and personal after the payment of all my just debts I will and devise to be equally divided into five equal shares or parts and distributed as follows. One share to Susan C. Dillard (wife of Perry Dillard) and the children of said Susan C. Dillard — To the sole and separate use of said Susan C. Dillard & her children born or to be born during her coverture with my son Perry Dillard. One share to my daughter Nancy Morris & her children to her and their sole and separate use free from the control or debts of her parent or any future husband. One share to my daughter Parmanus Dillard. One share to my daughter Parmanus Dillard in trust for the sole and separate use of my daughter Phoebe Gross & her children. One share to my son Royant Dillard & his heirs forever.

- Item 4 = I appoint my son Perry Willard trustee for my daughter Nancy Morris and her children - Also for my daughter in law Susan Willard & her children
- Item 5 = My son Steel Willard being in affluent circumstances I deem it unnecessary to give him any share of my estate & do hereby exclude him from any part or share of my estate
- Item 6 = I nominate and appoint my truly and beloved son Perry Willard Executor of this my last will and Testament
