She solemnly wills & decrees that her two sons James Summerling and Allison Summerling should inherit and have all the property both real & personal, of which she was possessed & that they should have all the property both real & personal to which she had any right, title interest or claim whatever.

And she expressly calls upon us to bear witness that this was her last will & testament. And we further state that the said Sarah was in sound and disposing memory & that her mind appeared as clear and sound as it ever had done.
