ledged, hath granted, bargained, sold and conveyed and do
by these presents grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said
Samuel Wetherford his heirs and assigns all that tract or
parcel of Land, Situate, lying and being in the County aforesaid
but in the County of Houston when surveyed being the whole of
tract No One hundred and Twenty Eight except Ten Acres in
the North East Corner of said Lot it now being occupied
by said Madsworth - So have and to hold said tract or
parcel of Land unto him the said Samuel Wetherford his heirs
and assigns together with all and singular the rights, tenements
and appurtenances thereto in any manner belonging
to him and their own proper use benefit and behoof forever
in fee simple. And the said Daniel Madsworth for himself
his heirs Executors and Administrators the said bargained
promised unto the said Samuel Wetherford his heirs, assigns
will warrant and forever defend the right and title thereof
against themselves and against the claim of all other persons
