I Wm B. Gamble of the County
and State aforesaid - being in my usual
good health and sound mind, and well
remembering that it is best to settle worldly
affairs, being blessed with health and strength
do make public and declare this my last
will and testament, hereby revoking all other
wills testaments by me made -

Item 1st-

I wish all my just debts paid -

Item 2- I give to my wife my house and lot with
city of Macaw where I reside, containing
half an acre more or less. " To have and
to hold, during her natural life and at her
death, to be sold, and the proceeds of sale
to be equally divided between my children
then living, or if either of my children, or
then dead, leaving children, the children of
such deceased child, to take in place of
deceased parent, I have and I have alike
and to share him forever. " This in view and
in bar of dower - " and support for our year
and all other claims or charges against my
Estate -

Item 3 All the rest and residue of my Estate - -
I give - To my property, notes - accounts
and all other real, or personal, Estate that
I may die possessed of, I will and direct
to be divided - by disinterested appraisers into
five (5) Equal Shares - or parts - and I give
and I give to my wife and each child I have and I have
alike

If a sale of my real Estate should
be necessary to secure an Equal division
among my Legates I authorize and em-
power my Executor and my Executors to
sell such real Estate - and divide and
distribute the proceeds of sale - Equally be-
-ween - my wife and children. I have and I have
alike forever. That portion or share which
falls to my wife is to her during her natural
life and no longer - and then her lot or
share to be equally divided between my chil-
-dren then living, and if any be dead, their
children, my child or children to take in
place of the deceased parent, I have and
I have alike and to share him forever

Item 4 I order will and direct that that
portion or share of my Estate that falls
to my two daughters and each of them

by settled and signed to them and each of them sole and separate use, free and exempt from the liens, incumbrances, liabilities or control of them or either of them present or future husbands. To have and to hold to them, and to their only during their natural lives, respectively, and at the death of ~~the~~ my daughter, then to their children respectively, and then this trust to cease, and the property to be delivered over to a lawfully appointed guardian for the children." My Executor to hold the property that may fall to my daughter and for their use until a lawful trustee shall be appointed and qualified as such to act as trustee for my daughter respectively.

My will and meaning is that my daughter shall, equally with my sons but at the same time to be held by them through a trustee and to protect them as far as I can against the misfortune or improvidence of their present or future husbands, or either of them -
