Item 1. I appoint my Brothers Benjamin Lockett
and James W. Ginsley Executors, of my Will
I appoint my wife Guardian of my Children
and their property.

Item 2. All the Negro I received from my Father's
Estate, and also all I received by my wife,
as also the wives husbands, and Children of the
two sets, of Negro. I wish kept and Equally
divided among my wife and Children. Share
and Share alike

Item 3. I wish my debt paid out of the Sale of
my Rail Road Bonds, as my work and
Contract progress, after the Contracts are com-
pleted, I wish all my other Negro sold as
soon as my Executors think best, and
out of the proceeds, any debt that my wife
owed at that time to be paid. The balance
to be invested in South Western Rail Road
or State in discretion of my Executors.

Item 4. All my whole Estate, of any kind I give
and divide Equally, Share and Share alike
among my wife and Children. The property
given my daughter to be her sole separate
Estate, for life, and to her Children after her
death - and I appoint my son Robert
Trustee for her property.

Item 5. All our house servants, viz. Nannie and her
Children, Minnie & Kate, Lacey, and Catherine
and her Children, I wish left for my wife
and Children, like those received by my wife
and from my Father. I wish a plantation
purchased, and the Negro kept for my wife
and Children, kept on it, for their support.
I wish my Negro Will and finally
