

Will of Abraham Strickland Secured

Georgia Brooks County } In the name of God. Amen

I Abraham Strickland of the County and State aforesaid being of sound disposing mind and memory and desirous of setting my worldly affairs while I have health and strength so to do. do make ordain and establish this my last Will and Testament hereby revoking all others at any time heretofore by me made

Item 1st

It is my Will and desire that as soon after my death as practicable that my Executor hereinafter appointed proceed to the settlement of all my just debts, as I have no desire that my Creditors shall be delayed in receiving the just dues from my Estate

Item 2^d

It is my Will and desire that my entire Estate both real and personal after paying my just debts remain undivided with my wife for the benefit and support of her and my family during her Natural life or widowhood and immediately after her death or intermarriage the proceeds to be equally divided among my legal heirs

Item 3^d

I do hereby appoint James McDonald my Executor to carry out the provisions of this my Will

In Testimony whereof I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my Seal in presence of the Subscribing Witnesses July 23rd 1864.
