 and memory, I do therefore make this my last Will and
 Testament, hereby revoking all others by me made
 I desire and direct that my body be buried in a decent

 I desire and direct that all my just debts be paid
 as early as practicable by my Executors herein
 after named —
 I desire and direct that my entire estate both person
 al and real be kept together during the lifetime of
