My Spirit I commend to the Father of Spirits
hoping to be found in the first resurrection. I hope
that my children will allow this my last Will to be
executed without dispute. Stern first, I direct that
all my just debts be paid as soon as practicable.
Stern 2nd. I give and bequeath to my son Dr. D. H.
Robb the sum of One dollar to be paid by my
Executor herein after named.

Stern 3rd I give and bequeath to my Daughter
Rosa McCall Wife of John L. McCall my House and
Lot Situated in the Town of Quitman near the
residence of Dr. B. Briggs, also all other property I
now have or might have at the time of my decease
whether real or personal or chose in action of every
kind or description, also all property that may
be inherited through or by me, and at the
death of my said daughter Rosa, said property
to go to and belong to my little grand daughter
Rosa Lina McCall in the event that she
should survive her mother to be and remain
their property in their exclusive management
and control, free from the constraints or limitations
of any and every person or persons whatsoever.
I am induced to make this disposition
of my property because my daughter Rosa
has taken such special care of me during the
last days of life, and because she gave up
to me the whole amount of her Father going to
her that I might with it pay for the aforesaid
house and lot in part, and she gave me some
two hundred dollars the result of her labor in
the year 1866 to finish paying for said
house and lot as far as possible.

I am 4th I hereby constitute and appoint my
 trusty friend William B. Bennett my Executor
 of this my last Will and Testament
 this August 29th 1891.
