

Will of Thomas H. Rogers Decd.

Georgia

Brooks County

In the name of God, Amen
 I, Thomas H. Rogers being of sound mind and of Good memory, with the other faculties of the mind in healthy exercise do make and publish this as my last Will and Testament hereby revoking all others which I have heretofore made.

Item 1st I direct that all of my debts shall be paid first.
 " 2nd I give and bequeath unto my beloved wife and Children all of my property to be equally divided
 " 3rd I wish all of my property to remain together, while the present war, with the united States continues.
 " 4th I wish my heirs to remain together on the same premises, as long as they can remain in quiet and peace with the other. If however one or more shall become dissatisfied, and wish not to remain with the others, then appraisers shall be appointed, who shall divide and set off their proportionable part of said estate.

5th And when it shall become necessary for my property to be divided between my heirs, it is my wish that my beloved wife, shall have a homestead tract of land I purchased from Hardy Hunter.
