I. Thomas Williams, of said state and County, being of
sound and disposing mind and memory.
Knowing that I must depart this life, deem it right and
proper, that I should make a disposition of the
property, which a Kind Providence has blessed me.

I do therefore make this my last Will and
Testament, hereby annulling and revoking all other
testaments made by me.

I desire and direct that my body be buried in a decent and Christian like manner, suitable to my circumstances and condition in life. My Soul I trust above all things into the hands of

soul. I trust - shall return to rest with God, who gave it.
I desire and direct - that all my just debts be paid
as practicable -

I desire and so direct that all my property be
left together after my just debts be paid as aforesaid
until my youngest child attains to the age of twenty
one years, I desire also that my plantation or farm
be carried on, and that the proceeds arising therefrom
be attributed to my beloved wife Sophia Williams
and be at her disposal for and during her natural
life, or widowhood for the express purpose of
maintaining and raising my minor children
and schooling them, and other expenses incident
to the family, and at the death or marriage of
my wife Sophia, then my whole estate, both
real and personal be sold as well as the proceeds
that may be ore hand at that time, and the
money arising from such sale, be put out
at interest until my wife Sophia

of age, But that no part of the Principality of my
real or personal shall be sold or disposed of
until the marriage or death of my

until the marriage or death of my wife, or until
the arriving at the age of maturity of my young-
est Child, shall take place. — I desire and
do direct that the division of my estate which I desire to
take place at the time specified above among all my
children equally share and share alike and that part
which falls to my daughters to be distributed in
proportion to their ages.

Will of Thomas Williams deceased
 provides and benefit my daughters from and except from
 the debts, liabilities, obligations, and control, of their present or
 future husbands, and should my daughters die leaving
 children, then this trust property, I direct, to vest absolutely
 in said children, if they die childless, then to revert to my
 heirs at law.

Item 5th
 I hereby constitute and appoint my beloved wife Sophia
 Williams my Executrix, and my sons John Williams
 and Sidney Williams, Executors of this my last Will and
