

Will of Eleanor D. C. Smith

In the Name of God

I Eleanor D. C. Smith of the county of Bryan and State aforesaid being of Sound & disposing Mind and Memory do Make, constitute and publish this my last Will and Testament hereby revoking all others by me heretofore made.

Item 1st

I commend my Soul to God who give it and my body to the dust from which it is. I desire that my body be buried in a decent and Christian like manner.

Item 2.

I give and bequeath unto my grand-daughter Irene Ophelia Smith my new feather Bed and all my bedclothes and my furniture.

Item 3.

I give and bequeath unto Samantha Jane Morgan my old Bed with three Calico Quilt and twenty Dollars in money to furnish her Bed.

Item 4.

I give and bequeath unto my daughter ~~Sarah Elizabeth Morgan~~ my daughter Eliza Jane Smith the sum of twenty Dollars to furnish her Bed.

Item 5.

I give and bequeath unto Sarah Elizabeth Morgan the sum of twenty Dollars

in Money, for the love and affection
which I have for her.

Item 6

I bequeath that Fanning & Morgan
receiv from the estate of My estate a just
amount of Money to be by them determined
for the Care taken of me by them and his
family. while I have been at his house
and during My sickness. I give unto My
son Wm. H. Smith and My daughter
Oliza J. Smith all the Money. if there be
any after Fanning & Morgan receive
what is justly due them and what I
have by bequeath unto him.

Item 7

I give and bequeath unto Fanning &
Morgan all my hog which I may
have at the time of My death. also
all my library Books. I also give him
my Mark and Brand.

Item 8

I desire as Expressed in the sixth item
of this My last Will that the Money
left after paying Fanning & Morgan
and also my Cattle be equally divided
between My son and daughter
Oliza J. Smith & William H. Smith.

Item 9

I desire that My daughter Oliza J.
Smith receive all my Cattle and
such trunks and boxes she may want
for her use and the balance of them
I desire to go to Mrs Sarah E. Morgan
wife of Fanning & Morgan.
