Item first

I give bequeath and devise to My
Wife Ida, G. Duggan the following
property to wit, One Hundred acres of
Land Now or left in said State & County
being a portion of a Tract of Land
deeded to Me by My Father N. J. Duggan
said one hundred acres hereby bequeath-
ed to My said Wife Ida, G. Duggan is to be
cut off of the East & South East end of
said tract or parcel of land to be cut
off and divided as follows commencing
at a corner at Cairney Bay near the
road running from N. J. Duggan to
old place known as the Jefferson Butler
old place, and running a S. 84° E. line
to the North boundary line of said
tract, running near and on the West
side of the drain or pond lying on the
West side of the field known as the old
Herr ground, which tract or parcel of
Land when so cut off and divided
and which I hereby bequeath to My
said Wife Ida, G. Duggan will be
described and bounded as follows to wit
on the north by lands of N. J. Duggan on the
East by lands James W. Duggan on the
South & South East by lands of James
B. Brown and on the West by the Balance
of said parcel of land to be cut off by

N. J. Duggan lying and being in the 1880
 5th District of Saic County on Joney Road
 containing one Hundred acres More or less
 together with all the rights and privileges
 thereto belonging free from all charges
 or limitation whatever to her own proper
 use benefit and behoof. I also give bequeath

 all my Household and Kitchen furniture
 including all beds and bedding of all kinds
 Pictures &c.

Item second,

 books and I desire that said library be
 kept in the custody and possession of my

 said Pratt. A. Williams arrives at such age
 as he will be able to take charge of the
 same and properly manage and use the books.

Second; a promissory note made payable to N. G. Brown for about Thirtt Dollars balance due January 1st 1888

Third; Two promissory notes made payable to N. G. Duggar aggregate amount of principle Three Hundred and Seventy dollars with interest, I desire that the above mentioned notes have priority of payment in turn as mentioned above provided the property fails to pay all the debts in full and if the proceeds of the sale of said property is sufficient I desire that all my debts be settled in full.
