 of this life, and desiring to make a dis-
 position of the property of which I am pos-
 sessed do hereby publish and declare this to be
 my last will and testament hereby rev-
 oking all other and former wills by me
 made

It is my will and desire that all my
 just debts be paid as soon after my
 death as possible

I give and bequeath unto my beloved
 wife Mary for and during her natural
 life the south half of lot 12 in
 Warren wards in the city of Savannah
 and the western half of lot 11 in
 seven wards in the city of Savan-
 nah Go together with the house and
 outhouse and all other improvements
 thereon, and after her death I give
 and bequeath the same to my son
 Jas. Henry to have and his heirs
 and assigns in fee simple

Thus

I give and bequeath unto my beloved
 wife Mary for and during her
 natural life all my real estate situated
 in the county of Bryan containing
 of about three hundred and fifty

Power of Land with the right power
and authority, to cut here and sell all
kinds of wood and timber from the same
without ~~the~~ impeachment of waste so long
as I shall live, and after her death

I give and bequeath the same to my
nephew John Henry unless the same life
tenant shall dispose of the same as men-
tioned in the last and fourth item of
this my will

It is my will and desire that if my
said wife Mary shall at any time
wish to dispose of the same while
mentioned in the third item of this my
last will and testament that she shall
have the right power and authority to
do so and after a sale thereof by her
that the interest of my said John Henry
in the same do in the proceeds thereof
shall cease, determine, and be forever
at an end; and that the proceeds of
said sale shall not absolutely in my
said wife Mary

wife Mary all my personal estate of
whatever description it may contain of
to have and to hold the same absolutely

death he has been seized of there real and
personal estate within the county and State of
Georgia the approbation and assent of said
testament and the power of granting the
administration of said said deceased the real

the said court being before ~~me~~ me
ye that the administrators of said said de-
ceased the real and personal estate of the said
deceased and of said testament and assent
of me remaining is hereby given as a
testament unto every thing which on this
day has appeared administratively with the
will annexed being first sworn on the Holy
Evangelists of actually being true and faithfully
to administer and to make a full and perfect
inventory of all and singular the real and
personal estate of the said deceased and to
Exhibit the same into the court of ordinary
of the said county to be recorded

when therunto required
