- 2 I desire to be buried in Bonaventure cemetery and that a tombstone costing Two Thousand \$2000 Dollars shall be erected over my grave.
- 3 I give and bequeath to Mr. Scheining Five hundred \$500 Dollars
- 4 I give and bequeath to J. T. Ruckel Five hundred \$500 Dollars
- 5 I give and bequeath to G. Butler of Tuborgon in the Kingdom of Wurtemberg the Sum of Five hundred \$500 Dollars
- 6 I give and bequeath to the village of Wankheim one Thousand \$1000 Dollars the same to be invested by the city Council of that village and the interest thereof shall be distributed among the poor annually on my birthday on the 30th day of March.
- 7 The rest of my estate I desire divided into two parts one to go to Virginia Schaefer W. and the other to his Sister Anna Maria Remmber now resident of Wankheim County of Tuborgon
