 and State aforesaid. Knowing the un-
 certainty of life and the certainty of
 Death. Do make this my last will and
 Testament as follows I give and beque-
 eth to my beloved wife and my son
 John all the property that I now pos-
 sess or that I may possess in the future
 up to the time of my death to be theirs
 and only theirs and to belong to them
 their heirs Executors and administrators
 forever. And I do most solemnly
 appoint John Harris as Executor to
 this my last Will and Testament

Letters Testamentary Issued to John Harris

Whereas at the September Term of
the Court of Ordinary for Bryan County
on the 14th day of September in the
year of our Lord one thousand eight
hundred and seventy six the last
Will and Testament of Fordon Harris
late of Bryan County in this State
the Will of Deceased was proved app-
roved and allowed of; the said Deceased
whilst he lived and at the time of his
death having been possessed of Divers
real and personal Estate within the County
and State aforesaid, the appointment and
allowing of Letters Testamentary; and the
power of granting the administration
of all and singular the real and personal
Estate of the said deceased to the
said Court being; Now, Should
know ye that the administration
of all and singular the real and
personal Estate of the said Deceased
and of testament, any manner of
way concerning is hereby granted
and committed unto the said John
Harris named as Executor in the
said last Will and Testament being
first sworn on the holy Evangelists
of almighty God well and fully

to Administer and to make a full
 and perfect inventory of all and singular
 the real and personal Estate of the said deceased
 and to exhibit the same into the Court of
 Ordinary of the said County in order to
 be recorded on or before the first Monday
 in December next ensuing and to render
 a just and true account calculation and
 reckoning thereof when thereunto required
