I Amen & Margaret Man of the County of
Bryan State aforesaid being of sound mind
disposing mind and memory and body
desirous to settle my worldly affairs which
I have done so to do make and publish
this my last will as follows: I beg
hereby all who hear me to witness
hereunto made.

I do direct my son John to sell
and I desire and wish that it may
be known to my wife and children like
wise to my friends that I am now
and sensible in my mind and
body.

I direct that the above be witnessed
and signed by two disinterested persons.

I do now direct that I do give
my old black silk dress
the one I have always had
and the one more of my mother and fit
for her and her husband they may
also be also given to my daughter
Pair of brass and green wooden back

and Two (2) cows and calves and 3 hens
and direct that said 18 Hrabeshan Cows
Smaller shall remain his and Grand daughter Ella
Eliza Spearman to be emancipated from the
Rents and interest accruing from Patrons
Plantation and I further do hereby direct
that I have by Grand Daughter Ella
a quarter of an acre without having any
uphold or children the property given and
bequeath in the the West side of my mill
to 18 Hrabeshan Cows in trust for the sole
and exclusive use of my grand daughter
Ella Spearman for 10 years and
bequeath to her the title of said
land in trust for the said and
descendents of Anna Maria Hrabes

I give and bequeath to Charles H
Rabes all his cows in trust for the
sole and exclusive use of Anna Maria Hrabes
Drops all her portion of land of
said land my wife does not hold over
her or doth not have the benefit of
said land to which I am entitled also
all the benefit of my stock of cattle
also all money that shall be left
after paying all my just debts
and expenses in case of my death
or if the said land fails of my
Mother and Anna Maria Hrabes also
direct that the said Charles H Rabes
have the benefit the proceeds of said
cattle and money failing that may
be left as aforesaid be applied to the
education of the said Anna Maria Hrabes.
