

# Will of Mrs Sinner

State of Georgia,  
Bryan County, } In the name of God  
Amen.

I Martha Sinner of said state and county being of advanced age and knowing the uncertainty of mortal life, though yet of sound and disposing memory deem it right and proper that I should make a disposition of the property with which a kind and merciful providence has blessed me & do therefore make this my last will and Testament, hereby revoking all others heretofore made by me.

Item 1<sup>st</sup> I desire and direct that my body be buried in a decent and christian like manner suitable to my circumstances and condition in life. My sole & trust shall return to our most merciful God who gave it -

Item 2<sup>nd</sup> I desire and direct that all my just debts be paid without delay by my Executor hereinafter named and appointed.

3<sup>rd</sup> Item. After satisfying the foregoing Items I desire and direct that all the remaining portion of my estate of which I may be possessed at the time of my death shall be equally divided between my two grand children, Eliza Tithman and Cynthia Sinner Wives of my beloved daughter Johannah Sinner now deceased said division between the said grand children Eliza Tithman and Cynthia Sinner to be affected by my Executor by a sale of the property or any part thereof which may seem

I repose full confidence. Executor of this  
my last Will and Testament.
