Item Second

I give devise and bequeath to my
 wife Sarah Duggan all such
 household and kitchen furniture,
 Beds and ~~bedsteads~~ bedding,
 that she may devise and select
 free from all charge or limitations
 whatever to her own proper use
 benefit and comfort

Item Third

I desire and direct that all the property both real and personal of which I may be possessed of at the time of my death be equally divided amongst my following children to wit Jasper & Duggar ~~Whitton~~ & bet Geo. W. Duggar, Charles M. Duggar Sarah F. Williams and my grand son Robert Duggar Sherr and share alike each accounting for all that they have received from me during my lifetime at such value as is mentioned and described in the receipts which they gave for the same, it being my intention and desire that each of my aforesaid named children and my aforesaid grand son each share equal and alike of all my entire property including as aforesaid what I have already given them. Should any of my said children herein named be dead when I die then their child or children shall be entitled to that portion of my property to which the father or mother would be entitled to under this my will.

Item Fourth

I desire and direct that any amount at the final distribution of my Estate which may be coming to my grand son Robert Duggar other than what has already been given to his father for which he is to account be taken charge of by my son James M. Duggar as Guardian for my said grand son and to that end I hereby constitute and appoint my

for the purpose aforesaid,

I hereby constitute and appoint
my Son James V. Duggar and
Charles M. Duggar Executors to
this my last Will and Testament.
